Wedged between Posh Shoes and the Shoe Repair Store in Hillsboro Village on 21<sup>st</sup> Avenue South, Nashville's Smallest Art Gallery earns the name through its unique use of space, energy, and cutting edge art. The entire gallery is a compact cube that is 29" in width, 39.5" in length, and 4.5" in depth conserving energy by using solar-powered lighting. Way to go for being green! To this day, the gallery has held six shows with subjects including evolution, time, and commercialization being portrayed with everything from acrylic to wax. One such show, "Evolution" by local artist and Professor Joseph Christy, caught my eye while traveling the streets with its various combinations of colors and materials transfixing my imagination into a comic-like world causing me to forget how long I had been standing immersed in the world of art. The wonder of this gallery is that it makes art immediately accessible for the average Nashvillian wandering the street. Whether grabbing a cup of coffee on the way to work or browsing the local shoe store, pedestrians are given the opportunity to view and become transformed by high quality innovative art work right on the street.
